ITAP is an aviation and technology park owned by Horry County and located in the heart of Myrtle Beach, SC, less than a mile from the beautiful beach front. Myrtle Beach is fast becoming a dynamic community, seeing over 37% population growth since 2000 (Source: U.S. Census 2010).

ITAP is adjacent to the 160 acre "Market Common" - an urban village town center with shops, restaurants and diverse residential areas. ITAP is also ideally located near Horry-Georgetown Technical College and the Pittsburgh Institute of Aeronautics's new aviation maintenance training facility (beginning September 2010).

- Additional 200 + acres are ideal for commercial/retail/office use

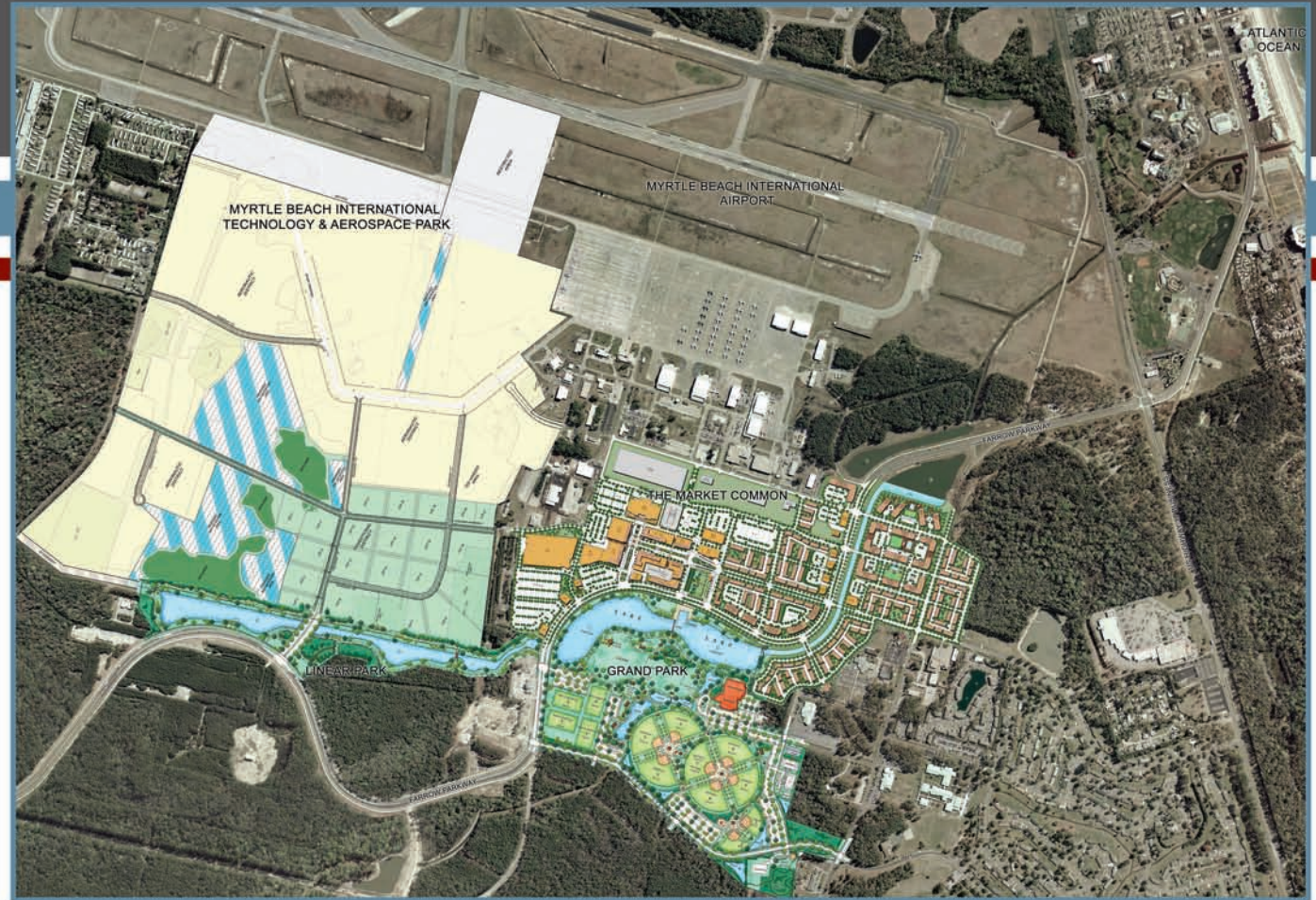
For reliability and redundancy, all fiber optic lines are buried and have instant re-routing over multiple fiber optic SONET rings.
